**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 3rd day of December, 2020, upon consideration of the court's September 18, 2020 order (Doc. 99) scheduling a fairness hearing for December 17, 2020, at the Ronald Reagan Federal Building & United States Courthouse, 228 Walnut Street, Harrisburg, PA 17101, and informing the parties and putative class members that "[t]he Fairness Hearing may be rescheduled, adjourned or continued, or converted to telephonic or video conference proceedings, without further notice to the Settlement Classes members," (*id.* ¶ 21), and the court observing that the notice distributed to putative class members regarding the class settlement advised

putative class members that “[t]he Court may . . . convert the hearing to a telephonic or video conference proceeding,” (Doc. 104-13 at 34), and that they should consult the settlement website for any such changes, (*id.*), and in light of the resurgence of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the precautions taken in this judicial district to limit in-person proceedings and thus limit the spread of the virus, see, e.g., M.D. PA. STANDING ORDER 20-29 (Nov. 19, 2020); M.D. PA. STANDING ORDER 20-30 (Nov. 30, 2020), it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The December 17, 2020 fairness hearing shall be held by videoconference. The court will promptly communicate to counsel details for connecting to the videoconference via email.
2. Counsel shall post this modification on the settlement website with dispatch and shall post the call-in instructions for connecting to the hearing promptly upon receipt.
